1) SPREAD THE WORD

- **Vote by Absentee Ballot** – Call the Registrar's office (757-393-8644) and request an absentee ballot application. Once you receive the application, fill it out and mail it back to the Registrar's office which will then mail a ballot to you.
- **Vote in Person Early** – Beginning on September 22nd, vote in person at the Registrar's office at Portsmouth City Hall. Voting early is like putting money in the bank! Also, once you vote, you are less likely to receive those annoying campaign flyers in the mail.
- **Vote in Person on Election Day** -- This is traditional, but you run the risk that illness or a family emergency might prevent you from getting out to vote.

2) SPREAD THE WORD

Tell your friends, family, and co-workers about these important races:

- **Senate District 18** (most of Portsmouth and part of Chesapeake)—Incumbent Democrat Louise Lucas finally faces a formidable opponent—**Republican** Anthony "Tony" A. Goodwin! Since Chesapeake doesn't want Lucas either, we now have a terrific chance to defeat Lucas!
- **Senate District 17** (four precincts in Churchland area of Portsmouth plus parts of several other cities)—**Republican** Emily Brewer and Democrat Clinton Jenkins are running since there is no incumbent.
- **House of Delegates District 88**—**Republican** Jim Wright is running against incumbent Democrat Don Scott.
